

COVID-19 Procedures for Spectators and Social Visitors to the Club

Updated October 1st 2020

It is accepted that there will be times the club has spectators. However, Worthing Hockey Club must ensure they are staying within the law and following England Hockey guidelines. Due to the recent government restrictions Worthing Hockey Club is discouraging large groups spectators at this time.

Worthing Hockey Club will adopt the following procedures for spectators:

1. We advise that there is only 1 spectator per participant
2. Spectators must stay in groups no larger than 6 and within each group they must remain socially distanced.
3. Spectators **MUST NOT** go onto the pitch at anytime. The pitch should only be used by players, coaches and umpires.
4. The toilets are open for spectators
5. The club house is open to any spectators as long as everyone signs into our clubhouse app

On Arrival:

1. Spectators should wait outside the big double gates
2. Spectators should not touch any gates/handles etc and should wait until a member of Worthing Hockey Club gives access
3. Once inside the big double gates spectators should ensure they are socially distanced at all times and must not go onto the pitch.
4. Once inside this area spectators will have to remain there until the end of the game.
5. Alternatively spectators can remain outside the big gates.
6. At the end of the game, spectators will be guided out via the gate at the other end of the pitch.
7. All spectators should leave the facilities as promptly as possible and without touching anything.
